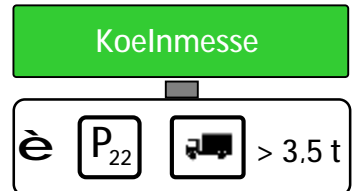

Construction and dismantling: General regulations

During the construction and dismantling periods, trucks are directed by a special guidance system close to the trade fair grounds.



The following regulations apply during spoga horse 2010 for vehicles over 3.5 tons:

1. Trucks over 3.5 tons will be directed to P 22 from the start of the construction period (August 30th, 2010).

At P 22 vehicles will be registered and access permission will be granted for entering the trade fair grounds.

Access will not be granted to the trade fair grounds unless:

- The exact delivery location (hall, stand number, service door) has been assigned
- The required logistics services have been provided by the contract transport agency
- The required areas for loading and unloading are available at the halls
- The customs handling can be completed

Our traffic staff at P 22 will direct trucks to the grounds.

2. When the dismantling period begins (on the last day of the trade fair), all arriving vehicles will be directed to P 22 by means of signposting and with Police assistance.

Vehicles may not access the trade fair grounds until 8:00 p.m. on September 7th, 2010

Special regulations apply to vehicles weighing less than 3.5 tons (see access regulations on the last day of the trade fair).

Please note:

Vehicles will not be granted access to the trade fair grounds unless they first go to P 22!

Access regulations

Last day of the fair/dismantling: September 7th, 2010

Arriving vehicles will be directed to P 22 by means of signposting and with Police assistance.

Vehicles used for dismantling will not be granted access to the grounds until 8:00 p.m. on the last day of the trade fair.

On the last day of the trade fair, owners/users of vehicles weighting up to 3.5 tons can drive onto the grounds from 5:45 p.m. to 7:45 p.m. with separate access permission. The relevant access permission can be obtained in a limited number by a deposit of € 100. 00. Payable only in cash.

Opening hours of the ticket counter

September 3rd and 4th, 2010: 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (Service-Center East)

September 7th, 2010: 1:00p.m. to 5:00 p.m. (Security Office East and parking P 22)

The deposit will be returned upon handing over of the original deposit receipt at the Gate A if the vehicle leaves by the exit deadline (7:45p.m.).
