General Traffic Regulations

Change in Traffic Routeing for Heavy-duty Vehicles over 30 Tons

Dear Exhibitor,

We have to inform you that Cologne's Zoobrücke bridge has been closed to heavy-duty vehicles over 30 tons gross vehicle weight since 15 October 2010.

For passenger cars there are no changes.

Due to a general disposition of the Cologne Police Authority trucks over 30 tons gross vehicle weight without a sticker for the environmental restriction zones are allowed access to Koelnmesse also via the environmental zones.

Closure of the Grenzstraße street tunnel B 55a for trucks over 7.5 tons

Because of ongoing fire safety improvements and the refurbishment work that will follow, the Grenzstraße street tunnel, which is located on the city motorway between the Zoobrücke bridge and the Köln Ost motorway interchange, has been closed to trucks over 7.5 tons since the beginning of August 2012 and will remain until further notice.

Therefore, please take the Köln-Buchforst exit and follow the posted detour route. This will take you to Frankfurter Straße, then onto the Vingster Ring and from there onto the eastern connecting motorway (A559) in the direction of the exhibition centre. As an alternative, you can take the A4 to the Gremberg interchange, which will also lead you onto the eastern connecting motorway (A559).

Environmental Zone

Most of Cologne's metropolitan area is a low emission zone, into which only vehicles sporting one of the stickers for emission group 4 (green sticker) are allowed to enter since July 2014.

The Koelnmesse exhibition center is, however, accessible for all types of vehicles, even if they do not bear one of the aforementioned stickers. You will find directions on how to reach the site without a sticker at map of low emission zone.

Due to a general disposition of the Cologne Police Authority trucks over 30 tons gross vehicle weight without a sticker for the environmental restriction zones are allowed access to Koelnmesse also via the environmental zones. This applies only to the official route deviations.

General Traffic Regulations

- The instructions of the traffic guidance/logistics staff of Koelnmesse have to be followed.
- The traffic regulations (StVO) apply for the entire fair grounds.
- The maximum speed permitted throughout the fair grounds is 30 km/h.
- Driving through the fair grounds with vehicles of all kinds is at one's own risk and is only permitted with the corresponding permission, a valid access pass or valid parking permit.
- Labelled traffic lanes, routes designated for the fire brigade and emergency routes (charging gates and emergency exits, etc.) must be kept free **at all times**.

Koelnmesse GmbH reserves the right to have vehicles, trailers, containers, vessels and empty containers of all kinds that are parked illegally or in a no-parking zone towed away without prior notice at the cost and risk of the causer, driver or owner. The guarding and keeping safe of such is excluded. The Messewache Nord (Security Office North) Tel. +49-221-821-2551 can provide information to the whereabouts of vehicles.

Instructions given by Koelnmesse staff with regard to traffic guidance and logistics must be followed.

Please note: Driving into the halls is not allowed!

Assembly vehicles of all kinds, as well as containers are not allowed to be parked in the fair grounds during the trade fair. However, for the fee of Euro 300.00 (plus 19% VAT) a limited number of parking spots for lorries, trailers and containers can be hired in the fair grounds. This fee applies exclusively for the duration of the event. Parking spots can be ordered via the Koelnmesse Service Portal using form T20. Regardless of the location of the container or vehicle or the usage of the same by persons, it may be necessary to attach a smoke detector that is connected to our fire alarm system. These can also be ordered via the Koelnmesse Service Portal.

Koelnmesse GmbH cannot store your goods temporarily or otherwise!

These forwarding agents will also gladly take care of the storage of your full containers before assembly begins or before the event as well as the storage of your empty containers during the event. These services can be ordered via the Koelnmesse Service Portal using the form T.18.

- Form T.18 for storage of your full containers before assembly begins, or before the event, as well as storage of your empty containers during the event.

- Form T.01 for an electric supply.
- Form T.02 for a water supply.
- Form T.23 for a smoke detector.
